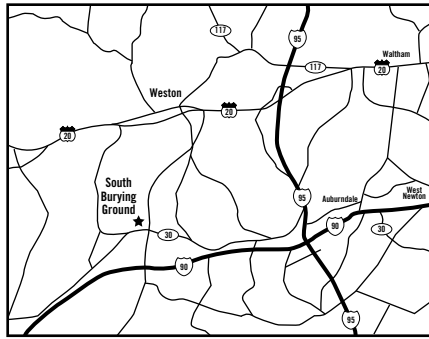

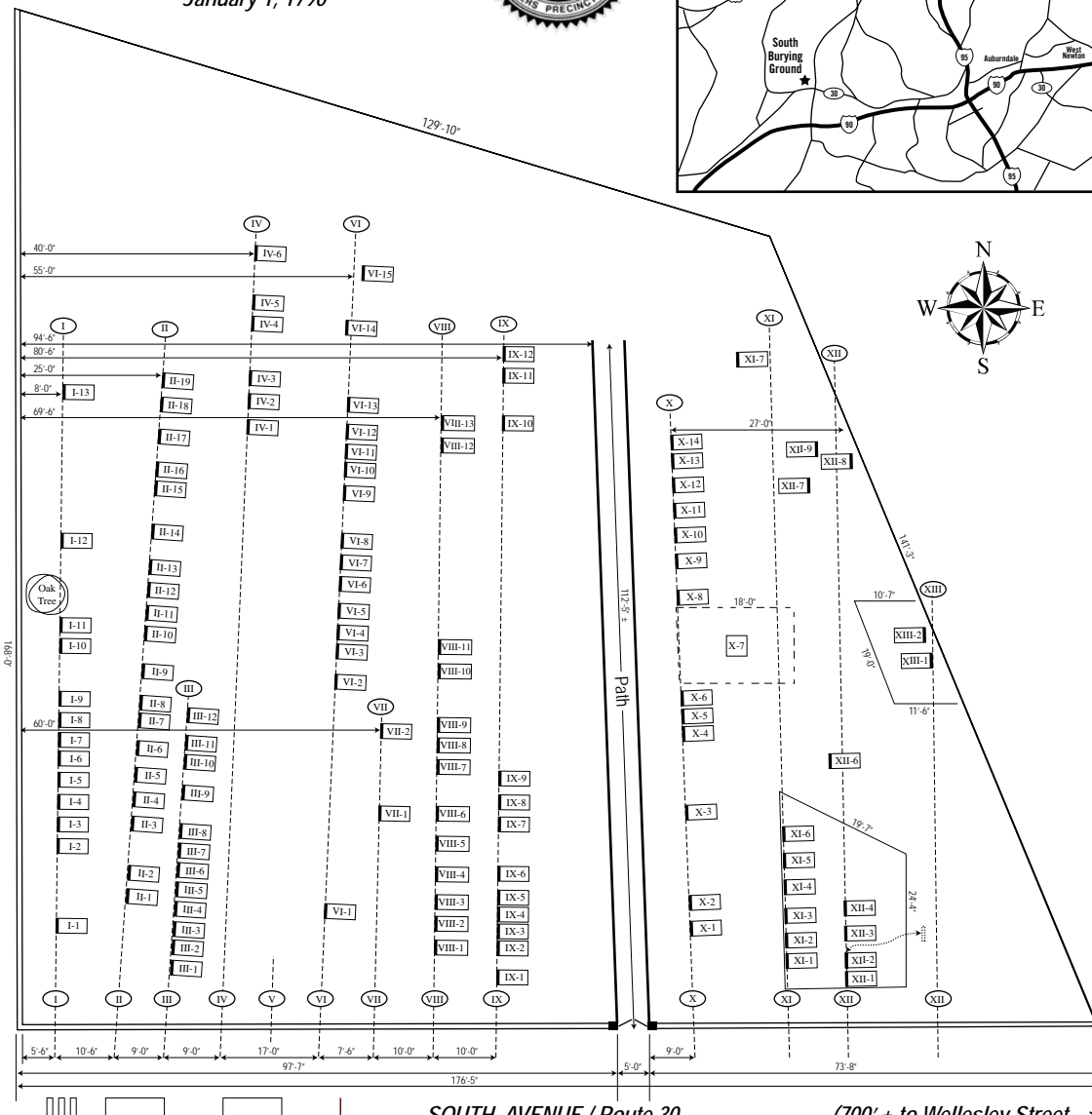

EXPLANATION
All known interments are listed alphabetically. The bulk of the data is to be found on pages 344-347 inclusive of the Town Records published in 1901 with Miss Mary Frances Pearce as its editor. A single asterisk (*) identifies data not in her book and discovered by us in 1977 via lime-worm gravestones or their modern replacements. A double asterisk (**) denotes that there is no known or visible marker, that no mention thereof is in the book, and that the information comes solely from records kept by the Cemetery Commission.

I denotes burials listed as "South Yard" in "Town of Weston: Births, Deaths and Marriages, 1707-1850. 1703 - Gravestones - 1900. Church Records 1709-1825"
